<p>Indian Healthcare has been corporatized over the last 10-15 years fundamentally changing the way it operates and functions. The industry is slated to grow at a CAGR of 12%. The total industry size is expected to touch US\$ 160 billion by 2017 and US\$ 280 billion by 2020.</p> <p>Having said this, the truth remains that Indian healthcare faces shortages of workforce and infrastructure along with inadequate hospital management teams, and a lack of focus on regulating costs on the supply side. However, today the sector is working closely with government, equipment manufacturers, pharma companies, insurance providers towards building transparency in costs and improving patient care outcomes. There is a growing openness to adopting technology to deliver healthcare remotely as well. This session will open the discussion on current attractive enablers in the Healthcare Sector which make it a profitable investment opportunity for global Pes/ Large Healthcare conglomerates etc.</p>
