Suggested Programme

With its consistent double-digit growth, the India Civil Aviation industry has ushered in a new era of expansion for the allied services related to Aviation besides Airlines, Airports i.e. Air Cargo, MRO, Catering, Online Travel Agency, Travel Portals et al. As per an ICAO study - “Economic benefits of civil aviation: ripples of prosperity” every 100 Rupees spent on air transport contributes to 325 Rupees worth of benefits, and every 100 direct jobs in air transport result in 610 jobs in the economy. The MRO services is estimated to be \$2 billion by 2020. Empirical data shows that for every \$1 million in revenue in the MRO sector, it has the potential to create 50 direct jobs. The international and domestic freight traffic have shown growth of 7.7 per cent in total freight traffic during the period April-September 2016-17.

The Session would aim to establish an integrated eco-system which will lead to significant growth of services in the civil aviation sector, which in turn would accelerate economic growth & employment.
